



TW Wines

The concept of TW was born on a fishing trip to Waikarimoana in 1997, where two of the group, Geordie Witters and Paul Tietjen, travelled to Lake Waikarimoana together. They talked along the way about grapes, wine, and a few other things, and realised they both had ideas of producing top quality wines. Both vineyards had accumulated several awards for wines produced from their respective vineyards so they decided to start research into prospective winemakers, and wineries that could blend the flavours from the two vineyards into a quality wine.

TW Gisborne Viognier 2008

Tasting Note

Bright pale straw in colour, with notes of jasmine flowers, golden peach and honey on the nose. The palate is lush with sweet stonefruit and honey, with fine acid throughout, giving structure and length.

Winemaking Techniques

The Viognier for this wine was hand harvested over a ten day period to ensure a maximum flavour spectrum and balanced acidity with moderate alcohol in the final wine. Long, slow whole bunch pressed to ensure elegance and retention of natural acid, briefly settled and then fermented in mature French barriques. Delicately fined with fresh skim milk prior to bottling.
